Remarks:

* This company was formerly Captain Miller's Company, Tennessee Cavalry, temporarily attached to Douglas' Battalion, Tennessee Partisan Rangers.

This regiment was formed about February 25, 1863, by the consolidation of Holman's Battalion Tennessee Partisan Rangers with a part of Douglas' Battalion Tennessee Partisan Rangers and the addition of other companies of Tennessee Cavalry which had formerly served in the 3d (Forrest's) Regiment Tennessee Cavalry and were transferred back to their original command about July, 1863. It was consolidated with the 10th Regiment Tennessee Cavalry in February, 1865, and finally paroled as the 10th and 11th Regiment Tennessee Cavalry at Gainesville, Alabama, in May, 1865.
